The Haiti Christian Development Fund is an indigenous, US based mission organization committed to evangelism, education, and community development. Its message of reconciliation through Christ has been a catalyst for change in this rural community. The Thomas family will be our host while in Haiti.

Why are we going?

We have the opportunity to help the community of Fond-des-Blancs recover from the effects of the recent earthquake by repairing schools, homes, and churches. We'll also spend a day at a local school interacting with kids.

Where are we staying?

The Thomas' guest house in Fond-des-Blancs. There are three rooms with bunk beds, two bathrooms, and a shared meeting space. We will bring food for breakfast and lunch and enjoy local fare for dinner.

What will be different from what I'm use to?

Travel will be difficult, and we'll do a lot of walking. Showers will be cold and we'll have to go get water everyday. Basically, you'll just have to be prepared to be flexible and adaptable.

What is the cost?

The cost for the trip is \$500. This includes Airfare, Lodging, Meals, Construction Costs, Travel Costs, and Insurance. A sample *Support Letter* will be provided for you if you want to send those to friends and family.

What do I need to do in advance?

Get a passport and talk to your doctor about proper immunizations. You'll also need to fill out a *Commitment Form* and return it to Marc by May 23rd. A final detail is that parents will need to complete a *Letter of Consent* and have it notarized before we leave.
